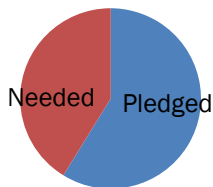

We are also working to get our contacts transferred, so that everything is in one shared database. We currently have over 200 contacts in each database and certainly don't want to overlook anyone. Our desire is to be more organized in order to maximize our efficiency in getting prayer requests to our prayer partners.
