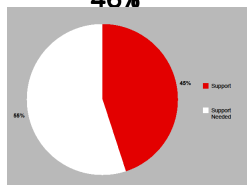

Yes, we are aware that not every individual or church will be able to give that amount per month, but as we continue to increase in our percentage of support, we will see every little bit making a difference for God's glory.

Other than a few days here and there between meetings, we have not had a vacation since we started deputation. We were able to have almost three weeks on the farm to relax and recuperate. We enjoyed the time off. but we are glad to be

The Lord has again provided some very encouraging meetings. We are blessed to be able to minister in these churches and to see God working in the lives of the people. There has been a good response to the messages. What a joy to see others making decisions to share the Gospel in their own communities! Dan had the opportunity to witness to a couple on the shore of the Atlantic. Unfortunately, the man claimed that he was atheist and refused to listen. The lady seemed open and took a tract. We have also been able to share the Gospel with an Indian lady at a hotel where we were staying and with some men at Dan's uncle's shop. Although we did not see them accept Christ, we are thankful that we were able to plant and water the seed of the Gospel.

It is especially encouraging when we are able to fellowship with Korean believers.

In one church we presented in, we met a Korean pastor of a deaf church. What made it more special is that our daughter, Alyssa, is learning sign language and was able to communicate a little with him.
